River City Christian Academy (RCCA) Scholarship Application

RCCA provides scholarships for educational studies. Students who are in good standing with RCCA and have been a member of RCCA for at least a year may apply by completing the following application form and return to Ann Allen, RCCA Administrator, P.O. BOX 1667, Decatur, AL 35602.

Fall and Spring semester scholarships are available with the School of Fine Arts (SoFA), First Baptist Decatur in disciplines of music, art and theatre for students who have finished the 8th grade or higher, Private music instruction scholarships will be provided at \$200 per semester. Students who receive private music instructions are eligible to continue receiving the scholarship for a total of four consecutive semesters. After this point, if the student wishes to continue private instruction at SoFA, they may reapply the following semester for an additional scholarship. Scholarships for art classes will be provided at \$50 per class. Theatre scholarships will be provided at \$50 per semester. Students that receive art and theatre scholarships are eligible to reapply for additional scholarships the following semester. Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the scholarship panel and awarded based on applicant essay and funds availability.

Summer scholarships are unique in that they are available in academic areas besides fine arts studies and available for students who have completed the 5th grade or higher. There are five summer scholarships offered in the amount of up to but not to exceed \$150 each. These scholarships are available on a one per student per summer availability. These scholarships can be used at the camp or festival of the students choosing.
